From dense wood, like pine etc; to hardwood ,like oak and exotic wood like merbau etc. This traditional looking finish leaves the grain and texture or the colored wood visible and accentuates the natural beauty of the wood.

Now this technology is available in the EU as a proven treatment for hardwood floors and all interior woodwork. The Legendary American Hard Wax Oil

will not crack, flake, peel or blister and still allows the wood to breave. It is water-repellent and dirt-resistant.

The Legendary American Hard Wax Oil is recommended to aplie over all American Wood Oil Rainbow pigmented/colored surfaces. It can also be used as a traditional finish on The Legendary American Wood Oil Transparent Gold or Warm Grey immediately.

tlf used as a primer and finish multiple coats are recommended. It continues to deliver beautifull results of an traditional wax finish and oil finish with the durability of modern finishing techniques.

# Water resistance:

Penetrates and water-repellent, can be used in rooms with high moisture content like bathrooms and kitchens.

## Composition:

Phenolic modified oil and wax based finish The solids portion of our finish is made up of 65% oil and waxes and solids, 35% resin and driers. The Legendary American Wood Oil Hard Wax Oil is DIN 68861 1A and DIN 53160 approved. Odor: faint/mild, odourless after drying

# Drying and curing :

 The first step is the evaporation of the solvent "carrier" system. The evaporation of solvent usually occurs in the first 2-4 hours with proper cross-ventilation.
The second step is the curing of the solids. The solids system completes 95%-98% of its cure cycle in 7-14 days with proper ventilation

#### <u>Finish:</u>

Dries to a flat, translucent, extra matt sheen. Can be used for all coats resulted in a final finish, 2-3 coats needed. Can be used for a primer, tone coat, 1 coat needed

### <u>Colors :</u>

Light beige-yellow, if used as a basic and the final finish coat. Choose your color by applying The Legendary American Wood Oil Rainbow Pigments sytem to form the basic coat. Available in 8 color pigments (white-grey-olive grey-cherry-belgian sweet -mahogany-brown-black) Finish off with The Legendary American Hard Wax Oil (traditionel concept).

#### Coverage:

On smooth surfaces, approximately 40-60 square meter per gallon (3,875 L); on rough surfaces, 25-35 square meter per gallon (3,875 L). These rates will vary depending upon the porosity of the surface

#### Packaging/Containers:

Available in 2,5 I containers and 10I containers.

#### Restrictions:

Proper ventilation and adequate air circulation must be provided when using any wood finishing materials. A lack of cross-ventilation (air exchange) provides less free oxygen, slowing the drying process. It is not recommended to use the material in non-ventilated area. It is the oxygen molecules in the air that interact with the material, creating a chemical reaction an causing the film to dry. Therefore the better the ventilation the quicker the film obtains its final hardness and other chemical resistance.

Not intended for exterior surfaces. For exterior use The Legendary American <u>Exterior</u> Wood Oil.

### Cleanup and Disposal :

Clean brushes and equipment with mineral spirits. Danger: Rags, steel wool, lambswool, waste, or any other materials soaked with The Legendary American Hard Wax Oil for hardwood floors, doors, tables, bartops, furniture may spontaneously catch fire if improperly discarded. Immediately after each use, place rags, steel wool, lambswool, waste or any other material in a sealed, water-filled metal container.

Dispose of empty cans or unused portion in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. Close container when not in use. Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) available upon request.

# Physical and Chemical Data:

Water Repellent: Yes Drying Time: Approximately 8 - 12 hours, depending on the temperature and humidity. The product shoud be applied at room temperature (min 16°C) and at normal air humidity (55 to 75%) Relative density: +- 0,92 (water=1) Flash Point: Over 73,5° C. V.O.C. Content Maximul of 287 grams per liter Proper surface preparation is the key to maximum finish performance.

# APPLICATION

#### surface preparation :

It is very important that, if used as a basic primer, the surface to be cleanof all dirt, loose fibres and other foreign matter. Previously finished wood should be stripped to bare wood. (final sanding with 100-120 disc to open the pores for maximum penetration) Vacuum and remove remaining dust with well wrung cloth. Surfaces must be structurally sound and absolutely dry.(Moisture content in the wood must be below 10%)

#### Application of Coating:

Stirring: Stir well before and occasionaly while using. Methods: Optimal results can be obtained by using a natural bristle brush , brushing machine or cotton cloth. Applu along the wood grain. Allow to dry for about 8-12h before applying an other finish coat. Sanding between coats is not necessary.

#### Number of Coats:

used as a finish coats: 2-3 coats are recommended Used for a primer, tone coat: only 1 coat

# Precautions:

Even though the recommended dry time is 8-12 hours. The Legendary American Hard Wax Oil hardened after 48 hours and resistant to furniture removal. Completely cure in 30-90 days
